The DIGI Heritage Hubs program is a 6-day immersive experience that seeks to foster collaboration and practice-based education in the fields of culture heritage and creative industry, with a focus on emerging technologies and digital tools that can enhance the user experiences of cultural heritage destinations. The program will bring together participants aged 18-35 years old, representing diverse professional backgrounds including archaeology, history, art history, museum studies, marketing and management for cultural heritage, design, animation, innovation, creative writing, and computer technologies, among others. The program will be implemented in two archaeological parks, Stobi in North Macedonia and Viminacium in Republic of Serbia, through two separate events in different time, where participants will have the opportunity to engage in skills development, mentoring, peer-to-peer learning, and international networking activities.
